



Alabama History Day is part of National History Day, a year-long program that offers teachers a **dynamic learning tool for the classroom**. It's designed to fit into classroom curricula, giving teachers, schools, and districts the opportunity to host local History Day showcases. Teachers can also participate in workshops and AHD professional development opportunities.

History Day also gives students the chance to become confident, curious learners, as they learn to do primary research and **engage with history in new and creative ways**. History Day is open to all students in grades 6-12. Students can compete in teams or individually, with the chance to advance from class and school contests to regional and state competitions.
